Essay Competition

Theme: *be Money Wi\$e – securing my future goals today*

For Students aged 15 – 19 years

Your grandparents gave you \$20 on your first birthday and since then, with the help of your parents, you have managed to save \$5,000. Now you are thinking to invest your savings to help you achieve one dream goal (e.g. to buy a car). Your parents have advised you to invest in the capital markets for better returns on your savings.

In an essay format:

- Discuss which type of capital market investment you would prefer e.g. units, stocks, or bonds and how much you would invest;
- State why you have chosen the investment(s) identified in (a) above i.e. what factors did you consider while choosing your investments (e.g. annual rate of return, risks associated with the investment etc.); and
- Provided that you are successful in your investment, clearly state what you plan to do with the returns (e.g. six monthly dividends) that you earn on your investments.

Each applicant must submit only one essay. The essay must address parts (a) to (c) above and must be written by the applicant. Help may be provided by a teacher and/or parents. The essay must be between 1,000 - 1,500 words in length.
