The Project Officer will work closely with the IT teams members, and alongside staff in various business units, to ensure systems are performing optimally. Candidates should possess development knowledge using technologies such as MS SQL, ASP.Net Web applications (MVC or Web Forms), IIS web app hosting, Visual Studio IDE, JavaScript, jQuery, HTML5, CSS3, Ajax, Bootstrap, Source Control with Azure DevOps Server and GIT and SSRS report writing knowledge is required. Knowledge in Microsoft Windows Server, Microsoft SharePoint, Microsoft Power BI, Microsoft Azure, and Technical certifications would be an advantage.

The successful candidate must possess at least a Bachelors Degree in Computing Science and Information System and at least 1 year of experience in a similar role.
